Le Québec n'est pas épargné par l'émergence et la prolifération des phénomènes de radicalisation menant à la violence : c'est ainsi que l'année 2015 a vu le départ de plusieurs jeunes Québécois vers la Syrie afin de rejoindre certains groupes extrémistes présents sur place. Le Collège de Maisonneuve a été particulièrement touché par cet état de fait et c'est à son instigation que le CPRMV a mené la présente étude, dans le but de documenter la situation, d'en tirer une analyse et d'offrir des recommandations.



Quebec has not been spared in the emergence and proliferation of radicalization leading to violence, which is how it came about that in 2015 several young Quebecers left for Syria to join extremist groups on the ground there. College de Maisonneuve has been hit especially hard by this state of affairs; it was at the instigation of the college that the CPRLV undertook the present study to document the situation, produce a cross-sectional analysis and propose recommendations.
