and the big Silicon Valley companies.

In the context of Donald Trump's second election, and more specifically during his election campaign, a term appeared, or rather reappeared, known as namely that of "technofascism". It has been observed the strong support given to the new American president by some of the giants of the web and social networks, as well as a growing aligment rapprochement between the Republican party

In the past, platforms were more inclined to show support for certain progressive causes (notably women's rights, the fight for LGBTQ+ rights or the inclusion of marginalized people). These platforms were even seen as tools conducive toof mobilization and activism, as observed during the Arab Spring or the "#MeToo" movement.

However, we are now witnessing a withdrawal of this support, most likely due to the rapprochement with the Trump administration. The various web giants now seem to support other ideological considerations views, including the defense of masculine identity, authoritarianism, homophobia, transphobia or even support offor the far right.

TO SUM UP

The term "technofascism" is therefore used to describe this rapprochement between social networking and web companies and an increasingly important radical fringe of the American political landscape, where economic, technological and political interests seem to be converginge.
